Title

PhD Project : oilseed rape production with companion plants

Introduction

The project: "Identification of Constraints and Assets of frost-sensitive intercrop with Rapeseed in Organic and conventional production systems (ICARO)"

Oilseed rape (OSR) is the main oilseed in Switzerland. Its production uses a large amount of pesticides that should be reduced to follow new directives to improve sustainability. It also requires a high nitrogen fertilization to reach its full potential. OSR production with companion plants is spreading across Europe, but due to mixed results, its surface is currently limited to about 5 %.

Thanks to better understanding of farmer's needs and most common issues, and also a better knowledge of mechanisms of the association, especially at the root level, would allow this technique to be widely adopted in Switzerland, resulting in a significant reduction of pesticide used in OSR production.

Tasks

You will :

- Carry out field and glasshouse work on crop associations, together with our field work team
- Work on the development of a decision support tool to help farmers choosing suitable species for crop association Conduct statistical analyses
- Propose and test solutions to improve crop management in OSR with companion plants
- Participate to the ICARO project through presentation to partners from OSR value chain and knowledge transfer to farmers
- Publish your research in peer-reviewed journals and present it at scientific conferences

Requirements

- Master degree in agronomy, environment science, biology or a related field
- Interest for applied research and field work
- Experience in dealing with standard PC programs
- Communicative and flexible personality with the ability to work independently and accurately
