

VOLLEYBALL RULES

HOW IS IT GOING TO WORK

- The tournament will take place on Saturday and Sunday for every team.
- Saturday: the A/B+, B-, C+, C- level league
- Sunday morning: End of the league phase and beginning of the elimination round
- Sunday afternoon: players of all levels will meet and have a lunch together in an amazing place, le Petit Palais des Sports of Gerland. Usually hosting the Lyon professional team of ASUL for its home-games, this place will surely be the perfect spot to enjoy all the finals of every level.

RULES

The rules that will be applied are the FIVB ones.

- Net faults shall be whistled only if it impedes the game (depending on the referee's appreciation).
- The team can only change two players per set.
- The entrances and exits of a libero player are not considered as a player change.
- If the ball touches a hard external thing (roof, signs, lights...) it will be considered as « out ». If it touches a cable, the game will have to be played again. However, if it touches a cable while a team is passing the ball between its own players, and the trajectory is lightly deviated, the game continues.
- Once the referee whistles the end of the game, the ongoing point has to be ended.
- If there is a draw at the end of the game, a last point must be played to determine a winner.
- In case of injury, a 5 player team is allowed to continue the tournament.
- The loan of a player is forbidden, except in cases of injury and with the approval of the organizing committee (as well as the one of the opponent team during the finals).

PROCESS OF A MATCH

- The duration of an entire match is not yet established, you will be informed on D day.
- 5-minute interval between each match (warm-up).

REFEREES

- 6 players will be named referees (1 main referee, 1 scorer, 4 line judges).
- When a match ends, the referee team has to give a fair-play point to one of the 2 teams (except for the finals).

MATCH POINTS

- Match points are yet to be determined, you will also be informed about that point on D day.
- Penalties might be applied in the following cases:
- Absent or incomplete referee team at the beginning of a match
- Absent or incomplete playing team at the beginning of a match
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or behavior and non-compliance with the rules
